1. 2022 IADR/APR General Session



The 2022 General Session took place virtually in June 22-25, 2022. There were 9 Interactive Talk Sessions created from abstracts submitted to the Orthodontic Research Group. There were 85 abstracts submitted and 85 abstracts accepted into the scientific program.
