
Annual Meeting Report

1. 2024 IADR/AADOCR/CADR General Session

The 2024 General Session took place from March 13 to March 16, 2024, in New Orleans, USA. This distinguished event featured the submission of 133 abstracts, representing a diverse range of orthodontic research. Participants engaged in four formal oral sessions and six poster sessions that showcased innovative studies and findings. Additionally, the session included two joint symposiums, hands-on workshops, and informative lunch-and-learn sessions, providing ample opportunities for professional development and collaboration in the field of orthodontics.

Sponsored by INNOVATION - an open access online Journal published by CTOR Press. The winner received a Certificate of Recognition and a \$500 USD check.




